SERMON NOTES

May 7, 2017

Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast."
~John 21:12

"COME AND HAVE BREAKFAST"

PETER DECIDES HE IS GOING FISHING. DUSK IS FALLING AND THE NIGHT IS NEAR AND THIS IS THE BEST TIME FOR FISHING. SEVERAL OTHER DISCIPLES DECIDE TO GO WITH PETER ON THIS FISHING ADVENTURE. THEIR LIVES HAVE BEEN STRESSED WITH THE DEATH OF JESUS AND HIS BURIAL AND HIS RESURRECTION. JESUS HAS APPEARED TO THEM TWICE SINCE HE HAS COME BACK TO LIFE. FISHING IS A GOOD WAY TO SPEND THEIR TIME AND TO CALM THEIR SOULS. The men take their boat and their nets and spend the night on the lake fishing. They fish all night and catch nothing. Then in the early morning they see a man on the beach. The man calls out to them asking them if they have caught anything. They tell him no. Their nets are empty. The man tells them to cast their net on the right side of the boat and that is where the fish are. **THEY CAST THEIR NET ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BOAT AND BEFORE LONG THEIR NET IS FULL OF LARGE FISH. . . .153 LARGE FISH TO BE EXACT! THEN THEY RECOGNIZE THAT THE MAN IS JESUS AND PETER LEAVES THE BOAT AND WADES TO SHORE TO GREET JESUS. THE OTHER DISCIPLES FOLLOW IN THE BOAT AND BRING IN THE HEAVY NET OF FISH. JESUS HAS A FIRE GOING AND COOKS FISH AND BREAD FOR THE MEN AND TELLS THEM TO COME AND HAVE BREAKFAST. JESUS SHARES BREAKFAST COOKED ON THE CAMPFIRE WITH THEM ON THE BEACH. . . .FISH AND BREAD!And I think how exciting that would be to have breakfast on the beach with Jesus. . . .And I think. . . .every morning I have breakfast with Jesus in my kitchen and I ask you. . . ."**Just how wonderful is that!" Thank you, Jesus, for loving. Thank you, God, for loving me. Thank you, Holy Spirit, for loving me and for being with me always. Amen
