1. *What ideas or themes seem to be en-
couraging as I pray and study His word?*
2. *How do I see churches in the New Testa-
ment ministering in ways that I can also
see my congregation ministering?*
3. *As I think about our church, what kind of
people has God brought together to form
our congregation? Are there clusters of
spiritual gifts or competencies or experi-
ence sets that I need to pay attention to?*
4. *What are our church's greatest re-
sources? Financial? A commitment to in-
volvement? A spirit of harmony and
peace? A position of influence? A particu-
lar skill set? Knowledge of God's Word?
(God can always bring more resources to a
church. But a sense of mission begins by
recognizing what God has already brought
to your congregation.*
